Temporary Closure of Dog Park for Volunteer Service Project

New Braunfels, TX - The New Braunfels Parks and Recreation Department is partnering with the Upward Bound Program at Texas State and city staff are expecting 110 volunteers to help with a several volunteer projects at the New Braunfels Puppy Playland Park, located at 1240 Landa Street on the corner of Landa Street and Loop 337 Access Road, on Friday, June 10th.

Upward Bound provides low income and first generation high school students with academic, cultural and personal support for the purposes of high school graduation, postsecondary enrollment, and lifelong success. The students range in age from middle school to high school.

All three dog areas of the New Braunfels Dog Park will be closed throughout this service project and will be re-opened to the public on the afternoon of Friday, June 10th.
