Prayer Service at Main Plaza Set for Monday

New Braunfels, Texas — In the wake of recent, tragic events across the country this week, and especially the killing of five Dallas Police Officers yesterday, Mayor Barron Casteel and the New Braunfels Ministerial Alliance invite the public to a special prayer service at the New Braunfels Main Plaza at 11:00 a.m. on Monday, July 11th.

“The outpouring of support for our local law enforcement officers has been tremendous,” said Mayor Casteel. “It’s important for our community to come together in times of senseless tragedy, and to pray for peace together.”

The Ministerial Alliance is an organization comprised of clergy members from various churches in the New Braunfels area. The members of the Alliance will lead the prayer service which will focus on a special prayer time for the city, country, citizens and law enforcement. The emphasis will be on the importance of everyone being treated with respect and the importance of reconciliation in light of recent events.
