Resident Input Requested on Proposed Mission Hill Park Master Plan

New Braunfels, Texas – The New Braunfels Parks and Recreation Department invites residents to share their input regarding the proposed Mission Hill Park Master Plan. A public meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, July 19th at 6:00 p.m. in Council Chambers at City Hall. The meeting will be held in conjunction with the regular monthly meeting of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board. Residents are encouraged to attend and share input on the proposed Mission Hill Park Master Plan.

“Input was sought from residents through a series of public meetings as well as an online engagement platform” said Stacey Dicke, Parks and Recreation Director. “Our consultants compiled the input and are proposing a plan that reflects the majority of desires.”

Mission Hill Park is located at 2100 Independence Drive, adjacent to the WestPoint Village shopping center. The 10 acre natural area features wooded and open areas and magnificent views of the city and surrounding area. The land was dedicated to the New Braunfels Park Foundation in 2012 and a contract with Schrickel, Rollins and Associates for development of a Master Plan was approved by City Council in January 2016.
