Live Oak Avenue Lane Closures

New Braunfels, TX – The City of New Braunfels has announced that traffic will be reduced to a single lane on sections of Live Oak Avenue, near Dry Comal Creek, on Thursday August 18th and Friday August 19th.

The lane closures provide access for drilling equipment to perform geotechnical testing within and adjacent to the roadway. The closures will be marked with signs and flagmen will be present to direct traffic around the work area. The information gathered from the testing will be used to further the design of drainage improvements on Live Oak Avenue at the Dry Comal low water crossing and near the intersection of Katy Street.

Drainage improvements on Live Oak Avenue are a part of the drainage and flood control projects approved under Proposition 2 of the 2013 Bond Program. This portion of the project is expected to be completed within the indicated times, weather and other factors permitting.
