Comal Cemetery Annual Clean Up Scheduled for Week of September 26th

New Braunfels, Texas – The New Braunfels Parks and Recreation Department, along with Maintenance Management Contracting Services, has scheduled this year's annual Comal Cemetery cleanup for the week of September 26th. Cleanup will include the removal of materials not in compliance with the City's ordinance, as well as tree and hedge trimming.

Per City Ordinance, section 26-6, temporary markers or ornaments are not allowed. The ordinance also states that all natural or artificial flowers must be placed securely in the flower vases, and that the planting of any trees, shrubs, flowers, etc., of any type is not permitted. Residents are asked to collect all personal ornaments and tributes they wish to keep by September 25th. All items left at grave sites following this date will be discarded.

"The annual cleanup process and enforcement of the ordinance contributes greatly to the preservation of our cemeteries," said Stacey Dicke, Parks and Recreation Director.

Cleanup will take place within the Comal Cemetery starting on Monday, September 26th and will conclude on Friday, September 30th, weather and other factors permitting. In an effort to maintain the grounds of the Comal Cemetery, City Ordinance section 26-6, will be enforced following the cleanup.
