City Comprehensive Plan Advisory Group Application Deadline Extended

New Braunfels, Texas — The City of New Braunfels is extending the deadline for receipt of submittal forms for individuals interested in participating on the subcommittees of the community’s Comprehensive Plan. A comprehensive plan includes community-driven long-range goals and objectives that guide local and regional decision making. One of the many methods used to obtain and vet input will be through nine subcommittees, or Plan Element Advisory Groups, anticipated to meet four or five times over an approximate nine month period. These topic-specific advisory groups include:

- Growth and Future Land Use
- Urban Design and Cultural, Heritage and Historic Preservation
- Parks and Recreation
- Economic Competitiveness
- Tourism
- Transportation
- Natural Resources and Infrastructure
- Education and Youth
- Facilities, Services and Capital Improvements

“You do not have to live inside the city limits to participate.” said Planning and Community Development Director Christopher Looney. “We welcome citizens, residents, property owners, business owners, neighborhood leaders, civic group members; you can be residents of the city, ETJ, surrounding area – anyone with a love of New Braunfels and a desire to provide their mark on the future of this great city.”

The new deadline to apply is October 17th. Looney indicated this additional time will provide more opportunities for outreach, such as at the upcoming National Night Out.
