River Activities Public Input Meeting Set

New Braunfels, Texas — New Braunfels residents are invited to participate in the third annual public input meeting on local river-related topics on Tuesday, October 11th, at 6:30 p.m., at the New Braunfels Civic Center in rooms 101-105. The Civic Center is located at 375 S. Castell Avenue.

The River Advisory Committee was appointed by City Council November of 2014 to advise them in river related matters, prudent river planning, activities, and programming, and also to recommend capital improvement projects. Since 2014, an annual public input meeting has been held to give citizens an opportunity to voice their opinions and suggestions for City of New Braunfels river operations.

The use of a wristband system, paid parking at Prince Solms Park, and the \$2.00 River Management fee paid by non-resident tubers on weekends and holidays between Memorial Day weekend and Labor Day have all resulted from recommendations made by the River Advisory Committee.

Citizens are encouraged to come and provide feedback and give suggestions for the River Advisory Committee to consider for the next river season.
