City Seeking Citizen Input On-Line for Street Improvement Program

New Braunfels, TX - The City of New Braunfels invites citizens to provide input on the FY 2016-2017 street improvement program, through an on-line survey, now through December 4th.

“We encouraged our citizens to collaborate and participate in decisions,” said Public Works Director Greg Malatek. “Therefore, we are asking our residents to provide input, identifying roadways they feel should be evaluated for potential inclusion in the City’s street improvement program.”

A public input meeting was held on November 21st, at New Braunfels City Hall, to provide citizens with information on the program and to take their comments. The City has developed the on-line survey to provide those who were unable to attend the meeting with an opportunity to express their opinions.
