**Invasive Visual Recording**

New Braunfels, Texas — The New Braunfels Police Department is seeking the public's help in identifying a recent Invasive Visual Recording suspect.

On Dec. 12, 2016, at approximately 7:00pm, an unknown male entered the Target store located in the 100 block of Creekside Way and allegedly attempted to take photographs from underneath the skirt of a 22-year old San Marcos female, without her knowledge or consent. Witnesses confronted the suspect who then exited the store and fled the scene. Video surveillance cameras captured the suspect leaving the store, and now New Braunfels Police and Comal County Crime Stoppers are seeking help from the public to identify the man.

Anyone with information on the identity of the suspect is asked to call Comal County Crime Stoppers, which is offering a reward of up to \$2000 for information that leads to an arrest and/or grand jury indictment.
