**Update: Bank Robbery  
Surveillance Photos of Suspect – Increased Crime Stoppers Reward**

New Braunfels, TX -- As the investigation into Tuesday's bank robbery in New Braunfels continues, NBPD detectives are releasing photos of the suspect, and Comal County Crime Stoppers is issuing an increased reward.

On Tuesday, Jan. 24, 2017, at approximately 12:20pm, the New Braunfels Police Department responded to First Commercial Bank in the 1500 block of South Seguin Avenue for a report of a bank robbery.

Officers arrived and learned that a male had entered the bank, handed the teller a note demanding cash, and then fled the scene with an undisclosed amount of money. No weapons were displayed and there were no injuries. The suspect is described as a black male with medium build who appears to be in his 30's or 40's. At the time of the robbery, the suspect was bald with a beard. He fled the scene in a white passenger car and was last seen heading in the direction of I-35.

Comal County Crime Stoppers is increasing its reward, offering up to \$5,000 for information on the identity or whereabouts of this suspect which leads to an arrest or grand jury indictment. That increased reward is valid for 30 days only, expiring Thursday, February 23, 2017.
