Landa Street Pedestrian and Bicycle Project Beginning

New Braunfels, TX – The City of New Braunfels has announced that construction of the Landa Street Pedestrian and Bicycle Project will begin on Wednesday, February 1st. The project addresses the segment of Landa Street from Walnut Avenue to Landa Park Drive. The scope of work includes sidewalks and bicycle lanes on both sides of the roadway segment, as well as the addition of a continuous center turn lane. The entire roadway segment will also be overlaid with 1.5” of asphalt and restriped.

MAC, Inc. is the contractor on this project and the Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT) will be responsible for the construction management and inspection. The project is scheduled to take between six and eight months, weather and other factors pending, and is being coordinated with the work being done on the new Community Recreation Center. TXDOT and the contractor will maintain two-way traffic on Landa Street throughout the project.

This project was awarded to the City of New Braunfels through the Texas Transportation Enhancement Program which is a state grant program that allows municipalities to stretch their budgets and build these types of projects when it might otherwise not be feasible.
