Landa Park Miniature Golf Grand Re-Opening Set for Saturday, July 8th

New Braunfels, Texas – The City invites the public to attend a ribbon cutting ceremony celebrating the grand reopening of Landa Park Miniature Golf on Saturday, July 8th at 10:00 a.m. The event will be held at the newly renovated course, located at 192 Landa Park Drive.

Following the ribbon cutting, families are invited to register for the Grand Re-Opening Miniature Golf Tournament. The tournament will be a four person scramble. The entry fee is \$10 per individual or \$28 for a four person team. The fee includes 18-hole tournament play, a light breakfast and prizes. The Landa Park Miniature Golf Course will be open for public play from noon until 10:00 p.m. beginning July 8th. Visitors that day will enjoy a complimentary round of miniature golf and a "Beat the Pro" leader board with prizes for those who beat the Pro's score.

The renovated 18-hole course boasts new greens, tricks and hole signage, improvements to the landscaping, ADA compliant access on holes one through nine, dressing up the edges of holes with flagstone, site lighting for extended evening play time and a new entryway pergola built by the New Braunfels Evening Lions Club.

The Landa Park Miniature Golf Course renovation project was partially funded by the New Braunfels Parks Foundation through proceeds from the Landa Park 80th Anniversary Gala. Local businesses and families sponsored holes at the course and the New Braunfels Industrial Development Board funded an additional \$75,000 towards completion of the project.
