Request for Tree Debris Pickup Deadline

New Braunfels, Texas — Requests from residents regarding pickup for tree debris related to Hurricane Harvey must be made by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 5, 2017.

Brush debris removal is scheduled to start on Thursday, August 31st and all requests made before September 5th will receive tree debris collection service. Requests made after September 5th will be treated as routine and any agreed upon service will be charged per the Solid Waste Ordinance. Residents can contact the City's Solid Waste and Recycling Division at 830-221-4040.

This call-in service is intended for residents with large tree trunks and high volumes of brush; it is best to place smaller limbs and small amounts of brush at the curb for regular, weekly Green Waste collection. City residents within Comal County can also self-haul brush debris to the Comal County Recycling and Chipping Center at 281 Resource Drive. For more information, contact Comal County at 830-643-3781 prior to hauling your debris there.
