**District 1 Councilmember George Green Stepping Down from City Council to Run for Comal County Office**

**New Braunfels, Texas** – City Councilmember George Green has announced his candidacy for Comal County Justice of the Peace Precinct 3; therefore, in accordance with state law, he must forfeit his Council position.

Until such time that a new representative is elected and sworn in for Council District 1, Mr. Green will continue to serve on the City Council.

“It has been a privilege to serve the citizens of New Braunfels and specifically District 1, for the past four and a half years. I am proud of the things I have been able to accomplish for my district,” said Green.

“Revitalization of the westside has been my focus during my time on the City Council, and projects like the installation of sidewalks at Lonestar Elementary, the construction of Morningside Park, numerous street enhancements and Eikel Park and Jesse Garcia Park playground replacements are projects that will serve the westside for years to come. I look forward to the completion of many other projects that were initiated during my tenure such as Solms/Morningside/Rueckle reconstruction, the Live Oak/Katy drainage project and the Das Rec Recreation Center from the 2013 Bond program.”

A special election to fill the District 1 seat will be called by the City Council on Monday, December 18, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. at New Braunfels City Hall. “Until that time, I encourage my constituents to continue to contact me for any assistance they may need” said Green.
