Temporary Closure of Comal River

New Braunfels, Texas — Due to recent heavy rains, the Comal River in New Braunfels has been temporarily closed to recreation. As of this release, the flow of the Comal River is at approximately 795cfs with water flowing over the Tube Chute dam. This closure will remain in effect until further notice. Conditions on the Comal River will be reevaluated until it is determined that the river can be reopened. Another press release will be sent once that determination has been made. There is currently no change in status to recreation on the Guadalupe River inside the city limits of New Braunfels.

It should be noted that forecasters with the National Weather Service are predicting more rainfall today and tomorrow (Saturday). Those factors will also play a role in future decisions made by city officials.

The New Braunfels Police Department would like to remind area drivers to use caution on area roads. Slow down, leave plenty of room between you and the person in front of you, and always remember: TURN AROUND, DON'T DROWN.
