## Old Central Fire Station 100th Birthday Celebration

**New Braunfels, Texas** – The City of New Braunfels is hosting a celebration marking the 100<sup>th</sup> Birthday of the Old Central Fire Station building at 169 S. Hill Avenue. This free event will take place on Saturday May 12<sup>th</sup> from noon-4:00 p.m. The event will feature a birthday cake, a kid's combat challenge obstacle course hosted by New Braunfels firefighters, fire station tours, museum tours, games and photo opportunities.

The Old Central Fire Station, which currently houses the New Braunfels Fire Museum, was built in 1918 by notable Texas architect Leo Dielmann and was the first fire station in New Braunfels. Come learn about the history of the building and the New Braunfels Fire Department while enjoying an afternoon of free fun, cake, and community.
