Southeast Library Branch Community Meeting

New Braunfels, Texas — The City of New Braunfels is inviting the public to participate in a community meeting regarding the potential development of a southeast library branch. The meeting will be held on Tuesday, July 31st, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., at Klein Road Elementary School, 2620 Klein Way.

On Monday, June 25, 2018, City Council approved the preliminary engineering contracts for multiple proposed 2019 Bond Program projects, including a branch of the public library in the south and east quadrant of New Braunfels. The preliminary design contract for the potential library has been awarded to 720design. The preliminary design will assist the City Council in identifying project feasibility for the proposed 2019 Bond Program.

The New Braunfels Public Library Master Plan, adopted in 2014, identified this section of town as underserved by the existing library facility, and recommended a branch location here in order to maintain the quality of library services throughout the community.

This first meeting will give the community a chance to look at some of the possible directions for the library and provide more detail for any elements desired by the community. All interested individuals, organizations and businesses from New Braunfels and the surrounding area are welcome to attend, learn about the potential project, and offer input.
