Westside Community Center Library Expansion Meeting

New Braunfels, Texas — The City of New Braunfels is inviting the public to participate in a community meeting regarding the potential expansion of the Westside Community Center Library. The meeting will be held on Thursday, August 2nd, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., at Westside Community Center, 2932 S. IH-35 Frontage Road.

On Monday, June 25, 2018, City Council approved the preliminary engineering contracts for multiple proposed 2019 Bond Program projects, including an expansion of the branch of the public library at the Westside Community Center. The preliminary design contract for the potential expansion has been awarded to Komatsu Architecture. The preliminary design will assist the City Council in identifying project feasibility for the proposed 2019 Bond Program.

This first meeting will provide the community with an opportunity to review options for the library. All interested individuals, organizations and businesses from New Braunfels and the surrounding area are welcome to attend, learn about the potential project, and offer input.
