Special guests for the event include a welcome and introduction by City Manager Robert Camareno, a cultural art display by artist/educator, Rey Gaytan, singer Ixtchel Fisher, DJ Oscar Zamora, Chef Mario Perez, and New Braunfels' very own Compania de Danza Folklorico will bring ballet folklorico to the event. There will opportunities for children to take part in cultural craft activities and face painting, and food vendors will be available on-site.
