North/South Roadway Collector Community Meeting

New Braunfels, Texas — The City of New Braunfels, is inviting the public to participate in a community meeting regarding the development of the proposed North/South Roadway Collector Project. The meeting will be held on Thursday, September 20, 2018, from 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., at Freiheit Elementary School, 2002 FM 1101, New Braunfels.

City Council has approved the preliminary engineering contracts for multiple proposed 2019 bond projects, including the proposed North/South Collector Project. The preliminary engineering contract for the potential roadway has been awarded to LJA Engineering. The preliminary engineering report will assist the City Council in identifying project feasibility for the 2019 Bond.

The proposed North/South Collector will be a roadway that will connect Business 35 (Elliot Knox Blvd), where it terminates at Interstate 35, to FM 1101 and continue through the August Fields Subdivision to connect to Alves Lane - which is currently being reconstructed as part of the 2013 Bond Program.

This public input meeting will allow the community to view the proposed schematic designs which will be presented to the Bond Advisory Committee. All interested individuals, organizations and businesses are encouraged to attend, learn about the project, and offer input.
