New Braunfels Public Library Adopts Auto-renewal Feature

New Braunfels, TX — Items checked out from the New Braunfels Public Library will now be auto-renewed at noon on their due date, if they are eligible for renewal.

“This feature gives us one more tool to better serve our library patrons,” said Library Director Gretchen Pruett. “Auto-renewal will minimize the potential for overdue fines and make returns easier for patrons who have limited access to transportation.”

Apollo, the library’s automation system, will look for items out each day that are due “today” and will renew them as long as there are no holds on the item and the item has not already exceeded the renewal limit.

Apollo will send a notification to the patron using the same method the patron has chosen for due date warnings (text or email; not phone). If multiple items are renewed for a patron, only one message will be sent.

The auto-renewal feature began on Monday, October 1st.
