Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan Public Meetings

New Braunfels, TX – The City of New Braunfels invites the public to attend the second set of upcoming meetings for the Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan (CSWMP). On Wednesday, December 5th, two public meeting sessions will present options for future implementation that address the needs highlighted in the previous sessions, as well as give the public a chance to provide feedback.

The City's consultant compiling the CSWMP and performing the analysis, SCS Engineers, will give a presentation that provides a menu of options available to Solid Waste and Recycling Division (SWRD). The City's SWRD provides a variety of services, including commercial garbage collection, operating a drop-off center for recycling, residential collection of garbage, recycling, and Green Waste, and drop-off events for special waste streams. The options presented will be expanded on in the final CSWMP report, which is expected to be completed in spring of 2019. The completed CSWMP will provide solid waste management strategies for City Council consideration that include benchmarks, improving operations, and increasing diversion over the next 20 years.

The first session will be from 9:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and will focus on SWRD services to the business community. The second meeting, from 5:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., will focus on residential SWRD services. Both meetings will be at 424 South Castell Ave, at the City Municipal Building. All are welcome to attend either meeting despite the slightly different focuses.
