We will transform the garden into a café, with music, a holiday craft and hot cocoa, and Chef Mario will use some WCC garden herbs in his vegetable stir fry.

“Chef Mario gives back to the community with a variety of special outreach events at the Westside Community Center every year — Safe Holiday Cooking at Thanksgiving, the Winter Garden Stir Fry and spring and summer cooking sessions,” Hernandez said.
