As Assistant City Manager in Live Oak, Ms. Matney has responsibility for Economic and Community Development, Code Enforcement, Municipal Court and Recreation. She led the City’s efforts to develop Live Oak’s new 112-acre Town Center and recruitment of Ikea.

As one of two Assistant City Managers in New Braunfels, Ms. Matney will have supervisory responsibility for the following areas: Public Works, Planning and Community Development, the New Braunfels Regional Airport and the City Secretary’s Office.
