‘Stewards of Children’ Training to be Held at Westside Community Center

New Braunfels, TX — The Children’s Advocacy Center of Comal County (CACCC) will be facilitating a training session for adults that covers how to prevent, recognize and react responsibly to child sexual abuse on Wednesday, April 17th, from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m., at the Westside Community Center, located at 2932 S. IH-35 Frontage Rd.

The training, Darkness to Light’s Stewards of Children, is recommended for members of the New Braunfels community who work or volunteer in youth-serving organizations, such as recreation facilities, faith centers or educational institutions, but anyone wanting to learn more about creating safer environments for children can attend.

“Child sexual abuse is an adult issue,” said CACCC Director of Outreach Shannon Dixon. “One in 10 children in the U.S. will be sexually abused before the age of 18. Darkness to Light believes that adults are responsible for the safety of children and that adults should be taking proactive steps to protect children from sexual abuse.”
