City Seeking Citizen Input On-Line for Street Maintenance Plan

New Braunfels, TX – The City of New Braunfels invites citizens to provide input on the fiscal year (FY) 2019/2020 street improvement program through an on-line survey, now through June 28th.

“We encourage citizens to collaborate and participate in decisions,” said Public Works Director Greg Malatek. “We’re asking our residents to provide input by identifying roadways they feel should be evaluated for potential inclusion in next years’ City Street Maintenance Plan.”

A public input meeting was held on June 18th to provide citizens with information on the program and to take their comments. The City has developed the on-line survey to provide those who were unable to attend the meeting with an opportunity to express their opinions.
