Annual Fourth of July Firework Spectacular

New Braunfels, TX – In honor of Independence Day, the City of New Braunfels is hosting the annual Fourth of July Fireworks display on Thursday, July 4th.

Festivities will kick off at 6:30 p.m. at the Landa Park Dance Slab with a free concert featuring The United States Airforce Band of the West. The sky will light up with the annual fireworks display at 9:15 p.m. Residents and visitors are encouraged to tune in to KGNB 1420 AM to listen to the live broadcast of patriotic music timed to accompany the fireworks display.

“We invite everyone to enjoy the annual firework spectacular. The fireworks will be fired from Landa Lake in Landa Park and are viewable from surrounding areas including, Landa Park, Fredericksburg Fields and the Landa Park Golf Course at Comal Springs - these will all be great viewing sites,” said Stacey Dicke, Parks and Recreation Director.

Seating will be available on the Landa Park Golf Course at Comal Springs for fireworks viewing starting at 6:00 p.m. Fireworks viewers will not be allowed to sit on putting greens.

In observance of the holiday, the Parks and Recreation Administrative Office, Landa Recreation Center, and Fischer Park Nature Education Center will be closed on Thursday, July 4th. The Landa Park Aquatic Complex will be open from 10:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m., Landa Park Boathouse will be open from Noon until 7:00 p.m., Landa Park Mini-Golf will be open from 10:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. and the Landa Park Golf Course at Comal Springs will be open from 6:00 a.m. and close at 2:00 p.m. for preparation for the evening fireworks display, the first 120 golfers will have an 8:00 a.m. shotgun start for public play, there will be no tee times.

The annual fireworks show is presented by the City of New Braunfels and H-E-B and sponsored KGNB 1420 AM. Residents and visitors are encouraged to come early, expect large crowds and be mindful of park rules. For additional information contact the City’s Parks and Recreation Department at 830-221-4350.
