District 3 Quarterly Citizen Forum Set for September 10th

New Braunfels, Texas — New Braunfels City Council District 3 Councilmember Harry Bowers will host his quarterly citizen forum on Tuesday, September 10th, beginning at 6:00 p.m., in the Tejas Room at City Hall. City Hall is located at 550 Landa Street.

"Our main presentation will be: Then and now - The Oak Run Parkway corridor from Loop 337 to its terminus at Veramendi," said Councilmember Bowers. "Greg Malatek, the City's Director of Public Works, will be on hand to address the historical infrastructure planning (roadways, sidewalks, bike lanes, speed limits, traffic calming measures, etc.) for this area. In addition, improvements that have been made and improvements that are scheduled will be discussed."

Like many areas of the City the Oak Run Parkway corridor has seen rapid growth and development.

Neighborhoods - such as The Enclave at Westpointe Village, Orion, Hunter's Creek, Oak Run - along with commercial businesses, apartment complexes, senior living, townhomes and others have either been built out or are in multiple phases of development today.

Attendees will have the opportunity to share ideas and concerns about current and future infrastructure serving this corridor and Councilmember Bowers will also include updates available since his last forum and hold a general question and answer session.
