RIOMobile Temporarily Out of Service

New Braunfels, TX — The New Braunfels Public Library’s bookmobile — known as the RIOmobile — will be off the road for the next two to three weeks due to a problem with its generator.

“We’ve consulted with multiple sources within the City, including the Fire Department,” said Outreach Librarian Jonathan Margheim, who is in charge of the RIOmobile. “At their recommendation, we’re now taking the RIOmobile to a specialist.”

Margheim said he will use the RIO’s downtime to refresh its collection and realign the collection to reflect circulation statistics. Library staff will also be able to tag RIOmobile material with RFID stickers.

RFID is a technology that uses various electronic devices to automate library transactions such as check-in and check-out, inventory management and security control.

Margheim will coordinate with the RIOmobile’s regular stops to make some alternate arrangements for certain services during this time.

RIOmobile patrons will not accrue late fines while the RIOmobile is out of service and, as always, can call Margheim at 830-221-4318 if they have any questions.
