Zoning Board of Adjustment to Hold April 23rd Meeting via Video Conference

New Braunfels, TX – The City of New Braunfels monthly Zoning Board of Adjustment meeting will be held, as scheduled, on Thursday, April 23, 2020, at 6:00pm. However, rather than being held in City Council Chambers, the meeting will, instead, be held online via video conference.

“To limit the potential spread of COVID-19 and protect the health of the public, we will use an online platform to host the meeting,” said Christopher Looney, Planning and Development Services Director. “We appreciate the flexibility of our residents and board members during this time.”

“The Board members and City staff will conduct the meeting from various locations remotely. We are committed to preserving public participation in the meetings,” said Stacy Snell, Planning Manager. “Applicants and the public will be able to dial in by phone or log in online to participate or view the meeting.”

For those who only want to view the meeting without participating, these meetings will continue to be broadcast as normal through the City website and on the Local Access Channels (Spectrum - Channel 21) and U-Verse (Channel 99).

ABOUT: Appointed by City Council, the Zoning Board of Adjustment is a five-member quasi-judicial body that considers requests to vary from the rules in the local zoning ordinance, and hears appeals of administrative determinations on the zoning ordinance. Decisions of the Zoning Board of Adjustment are final and appeals of their decisions may be made to District Court or County Court at Law.
